24 – Dixon Ticonderoga® Wood-Cased #2 Pencils, sharpened

- 6 Dixon Ticonderoga Erasable Checking Red Pencils, sharpened
- 2 White Block Erasers
- 1 Box of Crayola[®] 24-Count Crayons (Not "washable" crayons)
- 1 Box of Crayola 10-Count Broad Line Markers, Classic Colors
- 1 Box of Crayola 12-Count Colored Pencils
- 4 Expo Low-Odor Dry Erase Markers (thick), Black

At Meet the Teacher, please bring these supplies to school according to the directions below:

- In the pencil box: 3 pencils, 2 red pencils, 1 large eraser, 1 box of crayons, markers and colored pencils, 1 black dry eraser marker, and 1 glue stick. This box will be placed in your child's desk.
- In a gallon size Ziploc bag: labeled clearly with your child's name on the outside of the bag, place all the other supplies to be stored at school.

Place the plastic dividers in the rings of the binder and bring to school.

The composition notebooks and folders should be placed in a separate place in the backpack.

In the spring trimester, a few more school supplies will be requested for an animal classification project.

Label the following items with child's name:
