We appreciate your patience with our evolving Return to Campus Plan. As evidenced by today's Harris County press conference regarding *public and non-religious schools*, yesterday's CDC guidelines stressing "the importance of reopening America's schools this fall," and the recent decisions made by some of our area school districts making significant changes to their plans, this is a fluid situation with ever-changing information. Through working with local officials and medical professionals, and by tracking cases in zip codes prevalent to our families rather than in Harris County at large, we believe we can successfully and safely bring all of our students back to campus for in-person instruction beginning on August 24. Unlike the large public school districts in Harris County that have thousands of students and some classrooms with no windows or exterior doors, we are fortunate to have an open-concept campus and a much smaller group of students and families.
