Cumulative GPAs used to determine valedictory honors are calculated based on grades earned in all high school courses, including credits earned in 8th grade for Latin II and Algebra I. The rigor of the courses taken by the students is considered in the GPA calculation of valedictory honors.

Summa cum laude is the honor awarded to students achieving a 3.9 to 4.0 cumulative GPA. Magna cum laude is the honor awarded to students achieving a 3.75 to 3.89 cumulative GPA. Cum laude is the honor awarded to students achieving a 3.5 to 3.74 cumulative GPA.
