Our School

Providence Classical School is a distinctly Christian and Classical school established in 1999 in northwest Houston. "Christian" means we teach from a Biblical worldview and our curriculum is firmly rooted in God's Word. We acknowledge God as the source and author of all truth and view all subjects through this lens. Classical means that we use the time-tested model of the trivium to employ the children's God-given strengths across 3 stages of growth to help them learn.

Young children in the Grammar phase enjoy memorizing, singing, and rhymes, so a solid foundation is laid in each subject of study at this age. Middle School students are curious and inquisitive, so we develop their ability to reason and discern truth in the Logic phase. And high-school students want to express themselves, so we teach them how to present their ideas in an articulate and winsome manner in the Rhetoric phase.

The result is a PCS graduate who is a life-long learner and displays excellence in all they do. They know what they believe and why and can positively impact their culture for Christ.

Commonly Asked Questions

How is Providence different from other schools?

Some Christian schools label themselves as such by merely including a Bible class in the curriculum. At Providence Classical School, a Christian worldview permeates everything we do, teach, think, and say. Biblical thinking is integrated into every subject.

Why has Providence chosen to teach Latin?

PCS begins teaching Latin in the third grade and continues through the ninth grade because of its value for training the mind to think well. Not only does Latin build students' English vocabulary and grammar, it also strengthens the brain's ability to process new concepts, particularly other modern languages.

Are fine arts programs available?

Yes, all students in Pre-Kindergarten through 6th grade have both music and art classes each week. Beginning in 7th grade, choir and art classes are available as electives. There are also a number of musical ensembles available before and after school, including strings, hand bells, and recorder, as well as the opportunity to audition for a drama presentation each winter.

What sports are offered?

In both middle school and high school, students may participate in cross country, basketball, track, golf, and tennis. We offer volleyball for middle school and high school girls. PCS also offers both middle and high school baseball and football teams for boys.
